- Requested amount cannot exceed \$500 or 40 hours of support.

Brendle Group will review all applications with a priority given to organizations in Northern Colorado and Denver with a commitment to sustainability and social, economic, and/or environmental objectives.

- For awards made in May submit applications no later than March 31.
- For awards made in September submit applications no later than July 31.
- For awards made in January submit applications no later than November 31.
